

APPLIED MUSIC AUDITIONS, SELECTED

If you have not auditioned yet for lessons in an instrument or voice, you will need to contact the faculty member with whom you wish to study to arrange an audition time. This includes study either in the major instrument or in secondary instruments. For guitar, voice and piano, auditions are held for the area faculty as indicated below. Once you have been accepted into a studio, you do not need to re-audition each semester.
