NOTICE OF VACANCY

**Assistant Professor in Music Theory**

**Position:** Music Theory

**Responsibilities:** Teach required lower division undergraduate music theory courses and occasional elective courses in music theory at both the upper undergraduate and graduate levels. Assist in retention of music majors. Develop a body of published research that will lead to a strong national reputation as well as advancement in rank with tenure.

**Rank & Salary:** Assistant Professor; Salary = \$44,000. This is a full time probationary position leading to a tenure decision (tenure-track).

**Appointment Begins:** August 16, 2010.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Doctorate (or ABD with all degree requirements completed by August 2010) in Music Theory, Music Theory-Composition, or Composition; college or university teaching experience.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Strong commitment to teaching; interest in new pedagogical paradigms; record of success in scholarship and/or creative work.

**Applications:** Applications must include: (1) cover letter; (2) a detailed vita; (3) a list of three to five references including current contact information; (4) a list of courses or subject areas previously taught or within candidate's ability to teach, together with up to 3 sample syllabi; (5) 1-2 page essay on the pedagogical use of non-traditional teaching methods. Only complete applications will be considered.

Semifinalists will be asked to submit: (1) A Quick-Time readable DVD of candidate teaching a theory class (writing and analysis skills); (2) writing samples, such as professional publications, dissertation chapters (submit a maximum of two chapters), compositions, or presentations before professional music theory, composition, or related societies; (3) official transcripts.

**Deadline:** The committee will begin to review applications November 16, 2009 and continue until the position is filled.
