For ALL singers at the December 9 concert!!

PLAIN WHITE TOPS with sleeves and BLACK BOTTOMS

*-See above for information about what to wear
at the December 5 and December 11 events.-*

White tops should not have any colors or designs. They should be Plain White with Sleeves. Sleeves may be long or short, but there should be sleeves (not spaghetti straps or sleeveless).

Black Bottoms may be pants or skirts, but they should be plain black. Skirts should not be "too short." Shoes and socks/tights should also be black.
